TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

ESU (17-8, 15-5) hosts #16 Shippensburg (22-3, 18-3) to open the final week of the regular season. The Warriors have 2 games this week, while Ship finishes its campaign.

ESU will recognize its 2 seniors - Quindell Brice and Rasheed Moore - before its final home game of the regular season.

- Brice - 526 career pts in 2 seasons (10.1 ppg); including 10.6 ppg this year
- Moore - 1,586 career pts (4th at ESU), 738 rebounds (5th) (more on p. 4) (can become ESU's first 4-time All-PSAC East selection) (more on p. 3)

ESU will be the No. 3 seed in the PSAC East and will host a 1st-round tournament game on Monday, Feb. 27 vs. the No. 6 seed (yet to be determined).

Shippensburg enters 0.5 games behind Kutztown (22-2, 18-2) for the PSAC East lead.

- ESU is 6-5 since an 8-game win streak from Nov. 28-Jan. 9.
- Ship is 4-3 since opening 19-0, including a 93-70 loss at West Chester last Wednesday.
- ESU is 10-1 at home this season
- Ship is 8-2 on the road this season (lost 2 of last 3)

LAST TIME OUT at SHIPPENSBURG

ESU led by 11 with 13:16 left, but No. 8-ranked Shippensburg forced overtime and pulled out an 86-82 (OT) win to improve to 16-0 (12-0 PSAC) on Jan. 18. Sr. F **Rasheed Moore** (25 points) and R-So. F **Chris Bing** (15 points, 16 rebounds) led ESU.

Shippensburg's Justin McCarthur (24 pts) hit a 3 with 25 seconds left to send the game to OT. Dustin Sleva had 18 points and 15 boards, and all 5 Ship starters scored in double figures.
