POWELL RISING UP SINGLE-SEASON 3-POINT LIST

So. G **Noelle Powell** leads the PSAC in 3-point field goal percentage (41.0, 41-100), and her 41 made 3-pointers are tied for the ninth most by an ESU player all-time in a single season. Powell is only seven 3s away from taking sole possession of fourth place on that list. Jr. G **Imani Brown** is in eighth place (42 in 2015-16), while Sr. F **Allison Howard** (2015-16) and Maryellen Onofre (2004-05) are tied for sixth with 43. Onofre holds the all-time record with 63 made 3-pointers in 2005-06.

MILESTONE WATCH FOR HOWARD

After totaling 10 points and three rebounds in only 10 minutes of action on Wednesday, Howard is three points away from tying Onofre for ninth on ESU's all-time scoring list, and she is also just nine boards away from tying Sue Richards (1982-85) for ninth in rebounding. Howard's double-digit scoring effort against Cheyney was the 60th of her Warrior career (fifth most by an ESU player since 2002-03).

MORE ON TAMBURINI'S BIG NIGHT

Sr. G **Madison Tamburini** likes seeing Cheyney on the schedule. Prior to her 18-point effort (7-8 FG, 4-4 3FG) on Wednesday, Tamburini's previous scoring high was a 16-point performance against the Wolves on Dec. 19 last season. Those two games also mark the only two times she has made four 3-pointers as a Warrior. Tamburini entered the contest having hit 11 of 56 attempts from 3-point range (19.6%) on the year. With her three assists on Wednesday, she has 10 helpers over the last three games, and her three steals on Wednesday matched a season-high.

STAYING STRONG AT THE FT LINE

ESU is ranked third in the PSAC in FT% (73.1), and the Warriors have shot 75.0% or higher in 10 games this season (15-20, 75.0% vs. Cheyney on Wednesday). Several Warriors are shooting over 75 percent from the line this season. Tamburini (89.5%, 17-19), Fr. G **Sadie Cresswell** (81.3%, 13-16) and Fr. G **Tiffany Lapotsky** (79.2%, 19-24) have led the way in limited opportunities, while Powell (78.0%, 39-50) and Howard (76.5%, 62-81) are also over 75 percent. ESU has outshot opponents from the charity stripe in 17 of 20 contests on the year.

CONTROLLING THE GLASS

ESU has outrebounded its opponent in all four games of its current winning streak, continuing a season-long trend of rebounding margin having a big effect on the outcome. The Warriors are 10-1 when winning the battle on the glass and 2-6 when they are outrebounded (1-0 when tied). ESU grabbed a season-high 50 rebounds at Lock Haven last Saturday, led by eight from Imani Brown.

MORE SUPPORT FROM THE BENCH

ESU reserves outscored Cheyney's bench by a 33-12 margin on Saturday, with six different bench players contributing to that margin. Warrior subs have outscored the opposition in 18 of 20 games this season, doing so by 20+ points on seven occasions. ESU's first meeting against Millersville was one of the two times where the reserves did not outscore the opposition, as both benches scored 20 points apiece.

BIG SECOND HALF FOR C. BROWN

Sr. G **Courtney Brown** set a new career-high with 11 points in 14 minutes off the bench last Saturday at Lock Haven. After first entering the contest with 4:29 left in the third quarter, Brown hit four of her first seven attempts from the field, including three shots from long distance, to reach double figures for the first time in her career.
