TODAY'S MATCHUP

ESU begins a stretch of all PSAC East opponents to conclude the regular season with today's home contest against Bloomsburg. The Huskies (6-10, 3-7) have lost five of their last six games, including a 77-65 defeat at Millersville on Wednesday.

LAST TIME OUT

Sr. G **Imani Brown** totaled 17 points to move within five of 1,000 for her collegiate career, but it was not enough for ESU in a 79-61 defeat at hot-shooting IUP on Wednesday. The Crimson Hawks (14-0, 9-0 PSAC), who were ranked No. 3 in the most-recent WBCA national Division II rankings, maintained their perfect start to the season, while the Warriors (9-4, 7-2 PSAC) saw a four-game winning streak end. IUP hit 21 of 31 field goal attempts (67.7%) and 7 of 12 shots from 3-point range (58.3%) in the first half to take a 54-33 lead into the intermission.

BROWN APPROACHING 1,000 POINTS

Brown has a strong chance to become the 16th player in ESU history to reach 1,000 for her collegiate career this afternoon. Her 20.9 points per game are ranked third in the PSAC, and she has scored 20+ points in 8 of 13 contests on the year. Her season and career-high total of 35 points, set in ESU's 83-79 OT win over Mansfield on Dec. 30, is tied for the most by any PSAC player this season, and it was the most scored by a Warrior since Jackie Yandrisevits also had 35 points against Moravian on Jan. 9, 2008.

LIVE BY THE THREE, DIE BY THE THREE

ESU went 15 for 26 (57.7%) from 3-point range in last Saturday's 91-60 win over Lock Haven, and those 15 made 3's were the most for the program since at least 2002. During the past 15 seasons, the most the Warriors had made in a game was 14 at Goldey-Beacom on Nov. 16, 2004. On Wednesday, however, ESU shot a season-worst 3 for 23 (13.0%) from beyond the arc while scoring under 65 points for only the third time this year. The Warriors are shooting 32.9% overall from 3-point range, a figure which ranks sixth in the PSAC.

LOOKING AHEAD

ESU returns to the road for a 5:30 p.m. matchup at West Chester on Wednesday. The Golden Rams (10-4, 7-3) enter Saturday's game at Lock Haven on a five-game winning streak and only a half game behind ESU in the PSAC East standings.

SERIES HISTORY

Bloomsburg leads 51-25 in a series which dates back to 1979. The Warriors, though, have won each of the last four meetings, including convincing 87-61 and 75-55 triumphs in the two contests last season.

Sr. G **Imani Brown** (17.5 ppg), Jr. G **Noelle Powell** (16.5 ppg) and So. G **Tiffany Lapotsky** (11.0 ppg) were all strong against the Huskies last year. Prior to ESU's current win streak, BU had won 14 straight matchups from Jan. 20, 2010 through Dec. 1, 2016.

SCOUTING BLOOMSBURG

The Huskies have dropped five of their last six games, with the only win in that span a 69-60 comeback victory over Cheyney on Jan. 6. BU has scored fewer than 70 points in 15 of 16 games on the year, and the Huskies have been held under 60 points on 10 occasions.

BU lost a pair of 2016-17 second team All-PSAC East performers in Morgan Klunk and Alex Ross. Leading scorer Taylor Montana (8.8 ppg) has reached double figures in four of the last five contests, including a team-high 13 points in Wednesday's defeat at Millersville.

The Huskies average 20.8 turnovers per game and rank last in the conference in free throw percentage (59.5%).

HOT AND COLD FROM THE FT LINE

ESU went 22 for 24 (91.7%) from the free throw line in its rout of Lock Haven last Saturday. That percentage was the team's second-highest of the year, behind a perfect 12 for 12 output in a 94-74 win at Chestnut Hill on Nov. 22. Jr. G **Noelle Powell** (7-7) and Sr. G **Imani Brown** (6-6) combined to hit all 13 of their FT attempts.

The Warriors then earned a season-high 28 free throws at IUP on Wednesday, but they hit only 18 of those attempts (64.3%). For the year, though, ESU remains ranked third in the PSAC at 74.3%. Powell (91.3%, 21-23), So. G **Jordan Hertz** (80.0%, 20-25) and So. G **Tiffany Lapotsky** (77.5%, 31-40) lead the way at the charity stripe.

WARRIORS AGAINST THE EAST

ESU has won its first three matchups against PSAC East opponents this season, and the Warriors will likely be favored for most of the remaining 13 contests. Of the nine schools in the division, ESU (9-4, 7-2), West Chester (10-4, 7-3) and Kutztown (9-6, 4-5) are the only three with winning records. The Warriors went 12-4 against the East last season, outscoring opponents by an average of 11.8 points per game.

ACTIVE HANDS ON D

ESU registered a season-high 14 steals at IUP on Wednesday, reaching double digits in that category for a seventh time this season. Five players had multiple thefts, led by three apiece from Hertz, Lapotsky and Jr. G **Ann McKnight**. The Warriors ended the contest with a 22-13 advantage in turnovers, marking the 12th time in 13 games on the year that ESU has committed fewer giveaways than its opponent. The Warriors are fourth in the PSAC in turnover margin (+6.1) and seventh in steals per game (9.4).

FRESHMEN CONTRIBUTING ON OFFENSE

ESU's 91 points at Lock Haven last Saturday were aided by season-high scoring totals from Fr. G **Abby Schoffstall** (9 pts, 3-5 FG) and Fr. G **Amanda Pike** (8 pts, 3-4 FG). The two were a combined 4 for 4 from 3-point range, with each hitting both of their attempts from long distance. Schoffstall's points were her first of the year after missing nine games from Nov. 15 - Dec. 30 due to injury. The duo will look to return to scoring form today after going a combined 0 for 6 from the field at IUP on Wednesday.

HIGH POWERED OFFENSE

Despite totaling only 61 points against IUP, ESU remains fifth in the PSAC overall (second among East schools) in scoring offense at 75.4 points per game. The Warriors have scored 70+ points in 9 of 13 contests, going 8-1 in those games, and they have surpassed 90 points three times.

ESU has now scored 90+ points six times in the past three seasons under head coach **Diane Decker** after not having previously accomplished the feat since the 2007-08 campaign, when Decker coached the team in an interim capacity.

SWINT MAKING HER PRESENCE KNOWN IN THE PAINT

Fr. F **Kaitlyn Swint** is listed at 5-9, but that has not stopped her from registering at least one block in 3 of 4 appearances since her season debut on Dec. 30. Swint had a pair of rejections in that debut, and she totaled three of ESU's four blocks last Saturday at Lock Haven. Swint has added six points offensively on 3 of 6 shooting from the floor.

BAUMAN BACK IN THE FOLD

So. C **Alison Bauman** returned to action last Saturday following a three-game absence due to injury. Bauman played 14 minutes in the win over Lock Haven, and she upped that total to 18 minutes on Wednesday night to give ESU extra depth on the inside behind starting Fr. F **Marlene Bassett**.
