Overview

The East Stroudsburg Football Team looks to move to 2-0 this Saturday when the Warriors head to the Griffins of Seton Hill University.

ESU opened the 2019 season last Saturday with a 24-14 victory at Div. I FCS Wagner. It was the first time that ESU defeated an FCS program since 1994 (Lafayette).

The Loss for Wagner against the Warriors was the first time in program history that the Seahawks lost to a Div. II program.

Saturday's contest will be the 2019 season and home opener for the Griffins and first game under the direction of new head coach Daniel Day.

This will be the third all-time meeting between the Warriors and Griffins after the two sides first played on Sept. 14, 2013.

Seton Hill finished the 2018 season 1-10 overall and 1-6 in the PSAC West. The Griffins defeated Mercyhurst at home on Oct. 13 34-33.

Warrior Facts

- The Warriors have opened three of the last four seasons with a victory, including wins against Fairmont State and Brevard.
- Redshirt junior running back Devante Robinson recorded three touchdowns for the Warriors last Saturday, running for a pair and catching a 20-yard pass from redshirt sophomore quarterback Jake
- ESU looks to open the season with back-to-back victories for the first time since the 2013 season (American Int'l, Seton Hill). The Warriors finished the season 7-4.
- ESU won its only contest at Seton Hill 70-7 on Sept. 14, 2013.

Jimmy Terwilliger Head Football Coach

East Stroudsburg University

Jimmy Terwilliger is beginning his first full-season as head coach of the Warriors in 2019 after taking over for legendary head coach Denny Douds for the final two games last season.

Terwilliger went 1-1 to finish the 2018 season as the Warriors defeated Clarion on the road 23-17 on Nov. 10.

He was named the ninth head coach in program history on Feb. 25, 2019 in a press conference held in Koehler Fieldhouse. The previous men to coach the Warriors include Ralph Mitterling, Herb Lorenz, Ed Snavely, Eugene Martin, George Ockershausen, Jack Gregory, Charlie Reese, and Denny Douds.

Terwilliger, who graduated from ESU in 2007 is one of five head coaches in the PSAC who played at their alma mater, along with Chris Weibel (Clarion), Mark Maciejewski (Shippensburg), Gary Dunn (California), and Daniel Day (Seton Hill).

He is the second Harlon Hill Trophy recipient (NCAA DII's Top Football Player) to coach at his alma mater (Chris Hatcher, Valdosta State - 1994; 2000-06).

Terwilliger is in his fifth year overall on the Warriors' coaching staff after serving as the associate head coach in 2018 and the defensive backs coach from 2015-17.

He is one of two Terwilliger's on the staff as his father Mike Terwilliger enters his 42nd year as an assistant coach with ESU. He was Denny Douds' starting quarterback from 1974-77 and was a two-time first team All-PSAC East selection for the Warriors.

Jimmy Terwilliger would follow in his father's footsteps, starting under center from 2003-2006 and going 36-12 in his career, earning four first-team All-PSAC selections and becoming the first QB in conference history to do so.

Terwilliger set 18 NCAA DII and 2 NCAA all-division records, tying the all-time mark with 148 career touchdown passes. He also set the DII record for passing yards (14,350) and total offense (16,064).

He is one of 11 ESU quarterbacks to have been named to the Harlon Hill list since 1994 and was a four-time candidate. ESU has had 14 Harlon Hill cadidates, which is second-most in the PSAC and tied for fifth in DII since the awards inception in 1986.

Terwilliger was a member of the ESU coaching staff when the Warriors' Matt Soltes finished fourth on the list following the 2015 season.

Terwilliger was one of three families that threw at-least one touchdown pass under Douds was at ESU (Matt and Andy Soltes, Mike and Jimmy Terwilliger, and Brian and Matt Marshall).

Terwilliger guided the Warriors to the 2005 NCAA DII semifinals, where ESU would fall 55-20 against top-ranked Grand Valley State. ESU won three games in the tournament, including a 52-39 victory against No. 5 Bloomsburg.

Terwilliger mentored cornerback Teron Hobbs to All-PSAC accolades in his first season. He also saw the progression of free safety Billy Inge II and safety Justin Johnson, who finished first and second in DII in forced fumbles in 2017.

On the field, He led the Warriors to two NCAA DII Playoff appearances (2004 and 2005) and won the Northeast Region title in 2005. ESU won the PSAC East regular season title in 2003.

In his record-setting 2005 season, Terwilliger threw for 4,571 yards and 50 touchdowns, and ran for 389 yards and four TD for 4,960 yards of total offense, leading the Warriors to an 11-3 record.

He was the first quarterback in DII history with 3,000 yards of total offense in each of his four seasons. He was a three-time All-America selection, and was twice named to the AP Little All-America second team (2005 and 2006).

Terwilliger graduated from ESU in 2007 with a bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education and was named to the PSAC Top 10 in 2005 and 2006.

He was a health and physical education teacher for eight years in the East Stroudsburg, Pleasant Valley and Parkland school districts.

He helped Parkland to the District 11 championship in 2014 after leading Pleasant Valley to the District playoffs three times (2010, 2012, 2013) in five years as head coach. He coached PV to the Mountain Valley Conference championship in 2010 and was named the MVC Coach of the Year

ESU's Last <u>Game</u> (Sept. 7, 2019)

STATEN ISLAND, N.Y. - The ESU Football Team (1-0) stunned FCS DI Wagner (0-2) Saturday night at Hamline Field. The victory was the first for the Warriors against a FCS program since 1994.

STATS OF THE GAME:

- ESU junior running back Devante Robinson found the endzone three times for the Warriors in the contest, including a pair of rushing touchdowns.
- The Warriors answered a touchdown by the Seahawks on their opening drive of the game to knot the score 7-7 as Robinson punched the ball in from the one-yard line.
- ESU outscored Wagner 14-0 in the second quarter as the Warriors gained momentum on both sides of the football after some huge stop from the defense.
- The Warriors took a 21-7 lead with 9 minutes left in the second quarter as Robinson worked he way through the Seahawk defense to score from 10-yards out.
- ESU's defense set-up the drive after redshirt senior Joshua Taylor forced a fumble that would be picked up by redshirt freshman lahmere Crumpton
- Senior kicker Jordan Walters connected on his first field goal of the season, hitting from 45-yards to give ESU a 24-14 lead with 1:13 left in the fourth quarter.

UP NEXT:

The Warriors travel to Seton Hill for just the second-time in program history and first since 2013. Kick-off at Offutt Field is scheduled for 2 p.m.

Saturday's contest will be the first of 2019 for the Griffins, who look to improve on their lone victory against Mercyhurst last season

ESU hosts Edinboro in its 2019 home opener on Sept. 21 beginning at 1:05 p.m. at Eiler-Martin Stadium. It will be a Red Out Game as fans and students are asked to wear their Warrior Red.

Caught just two passes in the game but showed off his speed and ability as he finished with 52 yards receiving ... Reeled in a 41-yard pass from Cirillo ... Had 48 yards off two kickoff returns for ESU.

Justin Johnson (LB)


Finished with a team-best nine tackles in the game, including three solo tackles ... Had one tackle for loss in the contest ... Finished second in forced fumbles in 2017.
