TODAY'S MATCHUP

ESU continues its season-long seven-game roadtrip with PSAC East matchup against Mansfield. The Warriors have opened the season with five PSAC crossover matches, recording wins against Mercyhurst and Seton Hill. Mansfield looks to tally its first conference win of the season after opening 0-4 against teams from the West.

LAST TIME OUT

Sr. Noelle Powell scored a season-high 14 points and Jr. Dominique Rayam tallied a career-high 12 points for ESU as the Warriors dropped an 84-57 decision at No. 13 California.

Powell finished 6-of-10 from the field, while Rayam went 4-of-4 from the floor and 4-of-4 at the free-throw line. ESU held one lead in the contest as So. Amanda Pike drained a 3-pointer to make it 7-5 early in the first quarter.

WARRIORS NOTES

The Warriors have won two of their last three outings and set several season highs in a 73-58 victory against Seton Hill on Dec. 18. ESU went 34-of-68 (50%) from the field and recorded five blocks against the Griffins. Jr. Tiffany Lapotsky matched a career-high with 26 points while adding a career-best 13 rebounds.

ESU renewed its series with Adelphi University on Dec. 15 as the Warriors defeated the Panthers 81-74. The Victory snapped a two-game skid for ESU and its first win against Adelphi since 1987. So. Abby Schoffstall tallied a career-high seven assists in the contest, while Pike connected on five 3-pointers to finish with 16 points.



LOOKING AHEAD

ESU stay on the road for a pair of matches before returning home to Koehler Fieldhouse on Jan. 9 against Lock Haven. The Warriors face Le Moyne in a non-conference matchup on Jan. 2 in Syracuse, N.Y. and follow with a PSAC East contest against Shippensburg.

The Warriors host the Bald Eagles at 6 p.m. on Jan. 9, their first home contest in 37 days. ESU dropped a 75-68 decision against Slippery Rock at Koehler Fieldhouse on Dec. 3 after recording its first PSAC victory of the season against Mercyhurst on Dec. 1.

SERIES HISTORY

This will be the 75th all-time meeting between ESU and Mansfield. The Warriors lead the series 58-16 and have won 12-straight contests dating back to the 2013 season.

Mansfield swept the season-series against ESU in 2012, winning 70-58 on Jan. 11 and 81-71 on Feb. 8 at Decker Gymnasium.

The longest winning-streak in the series for ESU came between 1989-99 as the Warriors rattled-off 16 victories.

ESU recorded a pair of victories last season against the Mounties, including a 60-44 win at Mansfield on Feb. 3. Four Warriors scored double-digits in the win as Hertz, Lapotsky, So. Marlene Bassett, and Sr. Ann McKnight combined for 49 points.

SCOUTING MANSFIELD

Mansfield enters the contest seeking its first win of the season after dropping a pair of decisions against Edinboro and Mercyhurst.

The Mounties dropped a 98-93 heartbreaker against Pitt-Johnstown in double-overtime at home on Dec. 1. The Mountain Cats outscored Mansfield 11-6 in the second overtime to secure the win.

Erin Gibbons leads the Mounties offensively at 13.4 ppg and ranks 11th in 3-point scoring. Mia Leonard leads the PSAC in blocks (1.6) and is 7th in rebounding (7.6).

ROAD WARRIORS

ESU embarked on a seven-game road trip that started in Edinboro on Dec. 8 with the Warriors dropping a 93-89 decision in overtime against the Fighting Scots. The Warriors are currently 2-2 during the stretch with wins coming against Adelphi and Seton Hill. ESU closes its trip out by heading to Le Moyne (Jan. 2) and Shippensburg (Jan. 5).

LAPOTSKY PACES THE WARRIORS

Lapotsky has crossed the double-digit mark in scoring nine times this season for ESU. The junior from Ashland, Pa. has scored 20 or more points four times this season, including a career-best 26 points against Wheeling Jesuit and Seton Hill. She set a career-high in rebounds with 13 in a win at Seton Hill, which also marked her first double-double of the season.

Lapotsky is averaging 16.8 ppg, 5.9 rpg, and 2.6 apg while hitting 42.9% of her shots from the field. She is also hitting more than 30 percent of her 3-point attempts.

TURNOVERS, TURNOVERS, TURNOVERS

ESU has forced its opponents into 165 turnovers so far this season, which averages out to 15 per contest. The Warriors recorded a season-high 20 takeaways on Nov. 20 against Chestnut Hill and turned the ball over a season-low nine times. The Griffins tallied the win though as ESU shot a season-low 34 percent from the field.

Turnovers have plagued the Warriors over the last five games as ESU has committed 20-or-more in three of those contests, including a season-high 22 in a 84-57 loss against No. 13 California. Through the first-six games of the season, ESU had committed more than 15 turnovers just once (18, at Jefferson).

BASSETT CONTINUING OFFENSIVE BREAKTHROUGH

Bassett has scored 10+ points eight times through 11 games, and is averaging 12.4 points per game while shooting 62 percent from the field this season.

She connected on 83 percent of her shots (10-of-12) in scoring a career-high 25 points at home against Slippery Rock on Dec. 3. She would follow-up that performance by notching the first double-double (21 pts, 13 reb) of her career in an overtime loss at Edinboro on Dec. 8.

HERTZ IS HERE TO ASSIST

Hertz leads the PSAC in assists (67) and assists per game (6.1), while also ranking second in assist/turnover ratio (3.0). Her 67 assists in 11 games are 17 more than Bianca Jasper (CAL), who has 51 through 10 games.

Her 275 assists currently rank eighth all-time in program history as Hertz passed Maryellen Onofre (2003-07), who had 274 in her career. Hertz has recorded at-least four assists in each game this season and has tallied a season-high nine assists twice.

The Mechanicsburg, Pa. native has also tallied 25 steals this season and ranks sixth in the PSAC at 2.3 per contest.
